

Since the 1st of January 2018, a tourist tax has been levied on the Fougères Agglomération area. It allows to finance initiatives that encourage tourism. Tourist tax is payable by any person who is not a resident of the area of Fougères Agglomération.

Since the 1st of January 2020, the area of "Ille-et-Vilaine" has introduced an additional tax, increasing by 10% the rate of the current tourist tax.
